Regulations for the **English Impromptu Speech Competition**, 109th Academic Year, Tamkang University

- I. Goal: Impromptu speech demands proficient English oral speaking and strong reasoning logic. Its delivery requires skills in organization and presentation on stage. All these requirements help enhance students' English learning abilities.
- II. Time: 2021, April, 13th (Tuesday) 17:50-21:00 PM
- III. Venue: Ching-sheng International Conference Hall (T301), Tamkang University
- IV. Organizer: English Department, Tamkang University
- V. Eligibility: Undergraduates, day and night programs
- VI. Registration: Turn in your registration form to the Office of the English Department (FL207) from 08:00~17:00 between March 2nd and April 8th, 2021. Registration is limited. Upon registration, contestants will need to put down a deposit of 100-NT-dollars. Your deposit will be returned if the competition is fulfilled and withheld if not.

VII. Competition Rules:

- A. Number of Participants—Up to 25 individual participants.
- B. Order of Appearance—Determined by drawing the lot upon registration. Register at the venue between 17:50-18:20 PM.
- C. Topics for Speech—Determined by drawing the lot
- D. Conduct of Competition—
 - 1. Participants perform in their assigned order.
 - 2. Each participant will be given 3 minutes for preparation after drawing the lot
 - 3. Contestants may jot down their ideas on the lot and take their notes on stage when presenting (No extra pens and paper will be provided).
 - 4. Your 3 minutes begins once you start your vocal performance.
 - 5. The bell will ring once at 2 minutes 30 seconds and again at 3 minutes 30 seconds. When the bell rings for the second time at 3 minutes 30 seconds, the speaker will need to immediately exit the stage.
 - 6. No points will be taken off for performances which fall between 2 minutes 30 seconds to 3 minutes 30 seconds. Beyond that, points will be taken off accordingly.
